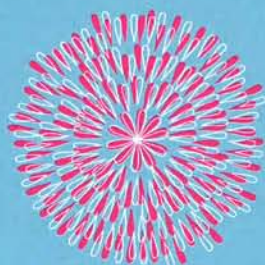
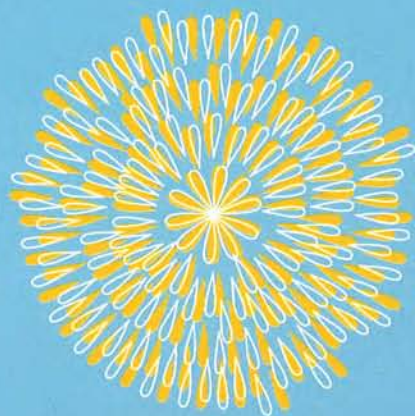
Our Letter To You.....

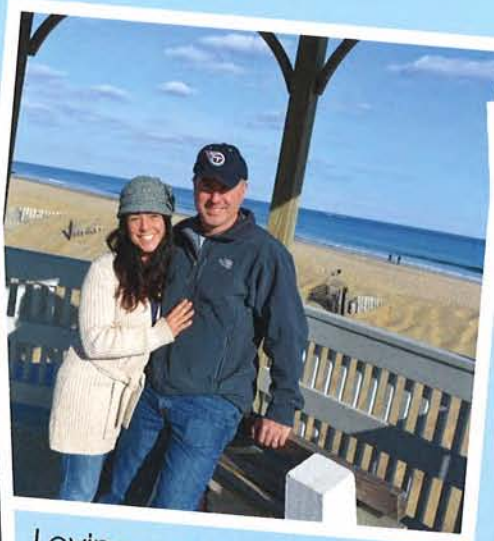

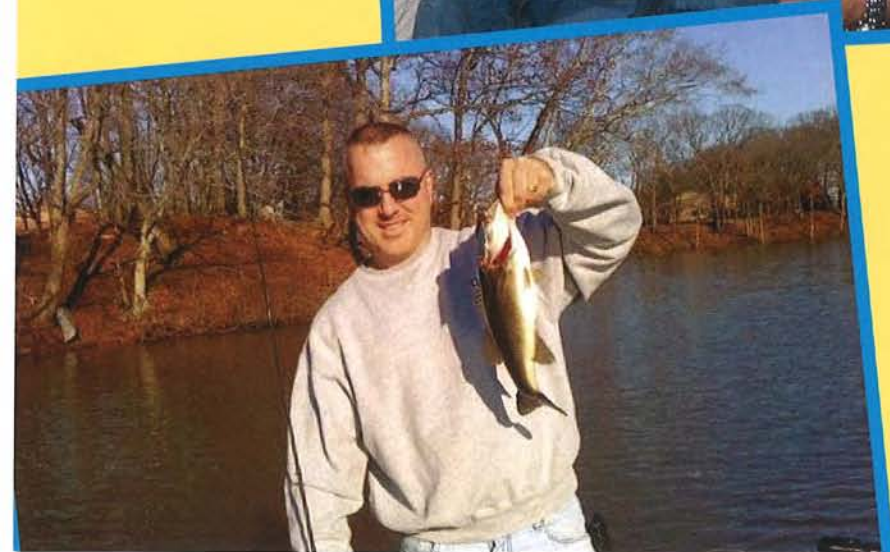

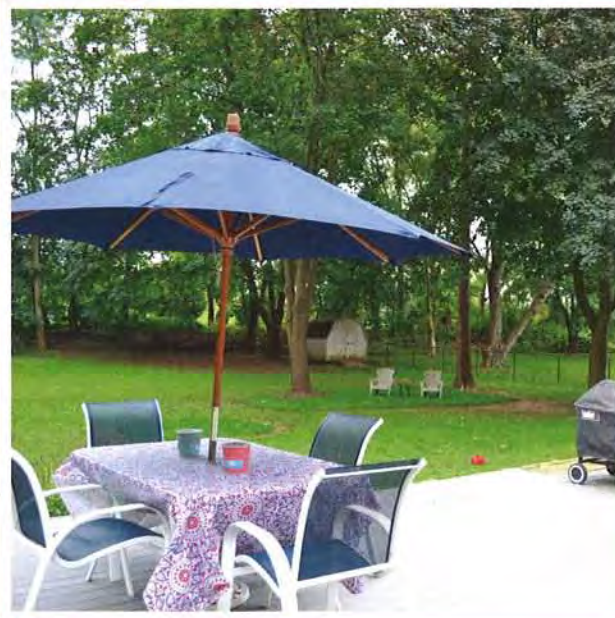
Our Home....



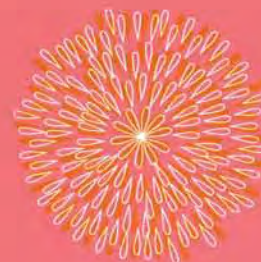

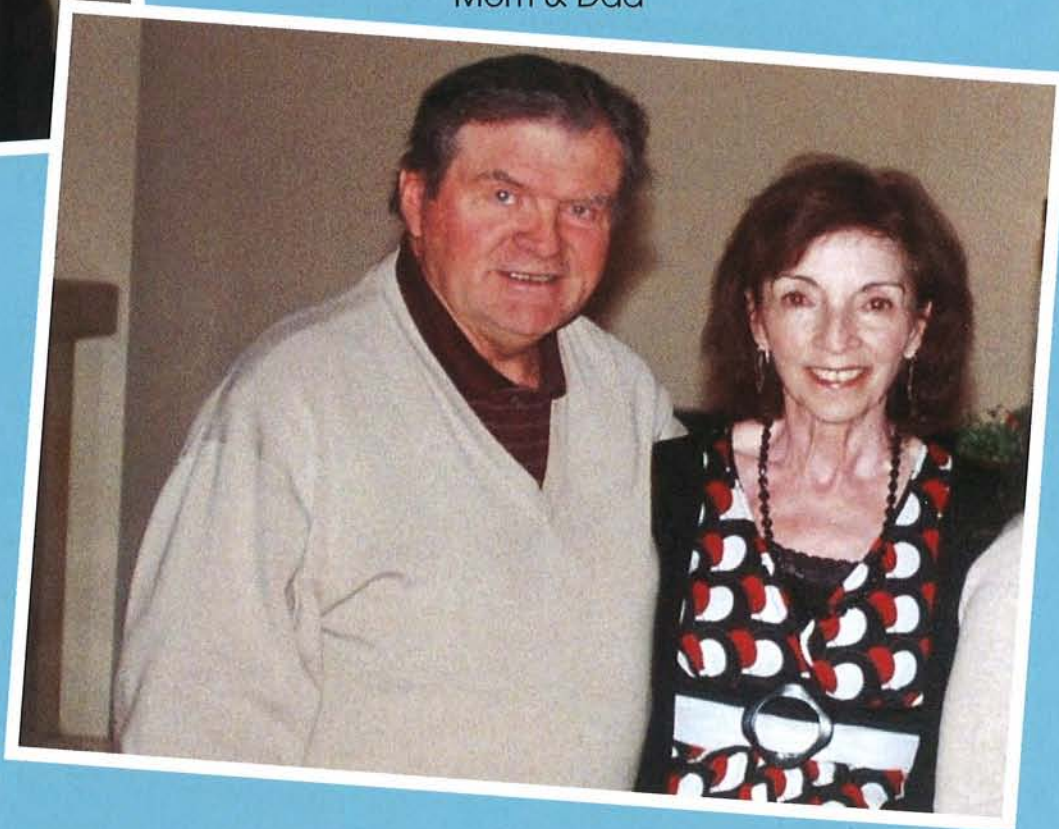

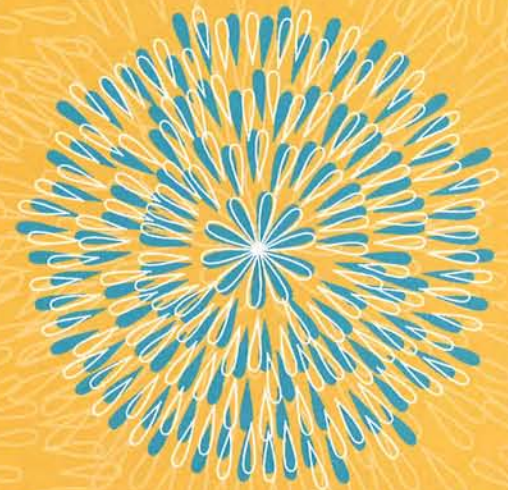




John's Family....

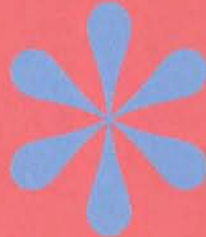




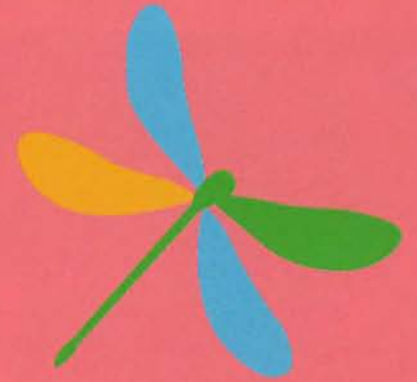
