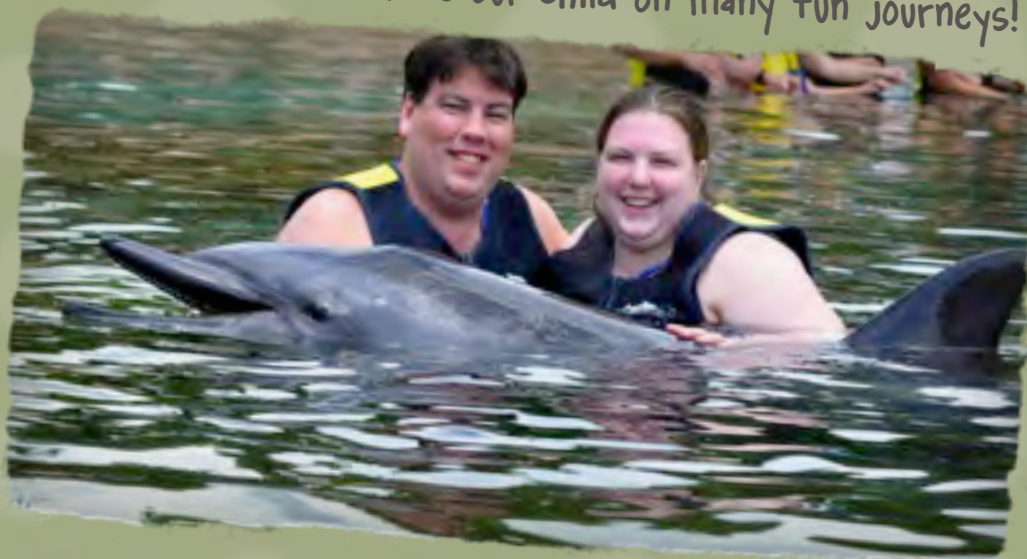


What Adoption Means To Us

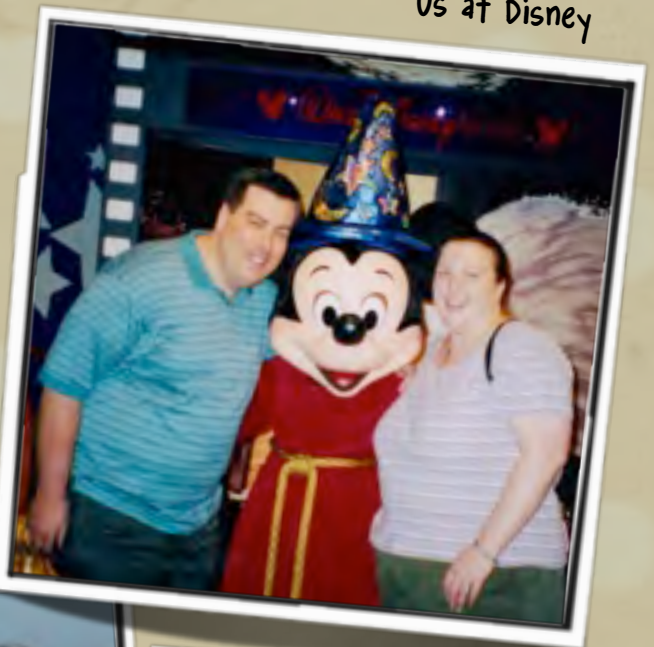

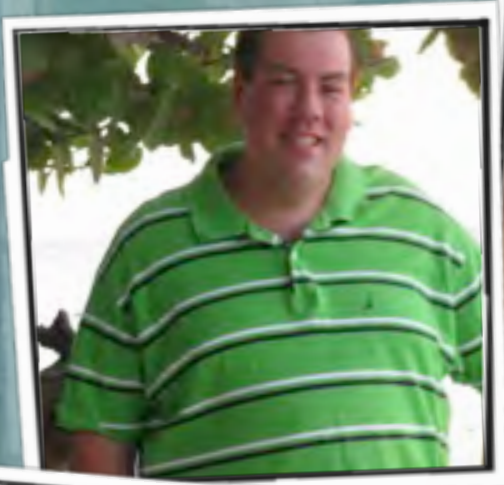
